Dear Friends and Family,

I am very excited to announce this Marian Shrines pilgrimage to Spain and France. Our pilgrimage begins in Fatima the site of one of the most famous apparitions of the Blessed Mother. On May 13, 1917, three young peasant children (Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco), all now Saints, received an apparition of the Blessed Mother. She gave them many important messages and taught them the need for prayer. Today, Fatima is visited by pilgrims from around the world who search for and find the messages of peace left by Mary for the world.

We will travel through Spain, along part of *The Camino de Santiago* (Way of St. James), a large network of ancient pilgrim routes stretching across Europe and coming together at the tomb of St. James in Santiago de Compostela in north-west Spain.

We will cross the Pyrenees Mountains to go to Lourdes, known today as the most famous healing Marian shrine of our times. On February 11, 1858, the Blessed Mother appeared to a young French peasant girl named Bernadette Soubirous. One important aspect of the Shrine of Lourdes is the miraculous water, first uncovered by Bernadette under the direction of the Virgin Mary and said to have a healing effect on many people.

I hope you will join me along our own custom designed pilgrimage route. This pilgrimage promises to be a rewarding and memorable journey for all.

Day 1 September 14, Friday: Depart USA

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport on Swiss Airlines for our flight to Lisbon via Zurich.

Complimentary dinner, breakfast, and beverages will be served inflight. (D,B)

Day 2 September 15, Saturday: Arrive Lisbon | Fatima

Late morning, arrive at Lisbon International Airport. Go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and our Peter's Way tour manager will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board our private coach bus and soon we will be on our way to Lisbon for an orientation tour of this beautiful Portuguese city. Independent lunch in Lisbon. In the afternoon, we will visit the Church of St. Anthony in Lisbon, where in 1195, St. Anthony of Padua, patron saint of Portugal, was born. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Anthony.** After Mass, we will visit the Cathedral, housing the Saint's baptismal font. After, we will pass by the Belem Quarter, Discoveries Monument and St. Jerome's Monastery and Belem Tower. Then, we continue to Fatima, where the Blessed Mother appeared in 1917 to three simple shepherd children and exhorted mankind to pray for world peace. Check-in at our hotel in Fatima. Dinner at the hotel restaurant.

After dinner, participate in the evening Rosary (9:30 – 10:15 pm) in the Chapel of the Apparitions followed by the Eucharistic Candlelight Procession. Overnight at the hotel in Fatima. (D)

Day 3 September 16, Sunday: Fatima | Valinhos | Aljustrel

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will celebrate **Holy Mass at the Chapel of Apparitions.** Then, our guide will take us on a tour of the Shrine of Fatima. In May 1917, Our Lady was seen several times by three shepherd children—Jacinta, Francisco and Lucia—at a place called Cova da Iria, where the Basilica now stands. Visit the tombs of the children and the Chapel of the Apparitions known as the Capelinha. Continue on to visit Aljustrel, the hamlet where the three children lived and view their untouched homes. Visit Valinhos where Our Lady appeared after the children's return from prison. "O My Jesus, Forgive us Our Sins, save us from the Fires of Hell, lead all Souls to Heaven, especially those most in need of Thy Mercy." Following the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way) built by Hungarian refugees that culminates in the Chapel of Calvary - which overlooks all of Fatima. Visit the Church where the children were baptized. Independent lunch and remainder of the day will be free for private devotions. Dinner at the hotel restaurant. After dinner, participate in the evening Rosary (9:30 – 10:15 pm) in the Chapel of the Apparitions followed by the Eucharistic Candlelight Procession. Overnight at the hotel in Fatima. (B,D)

Day 4 September 17, Monday: Fatima | Coimbra | Santiago de Compostela

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, leave Fatima and drive north to Santiago de Compostela. En route, stop at Coimbra to visit the Carmelite Monastery where Sister Lucia, one of the three shepherd children, lived until her death in 2005. **Celebrate Mass at the Carmelite Monastery.** Independent lunch. After lunch, continue to Santiago de Compostela, the destination of the important medieval pilgrimage route "The Way of St. James." Pass through the northern border of Portugal, where the rural population still uses traditional farming methods. The highway to Santiago offers spectacular views of the Rias Baixas, the deep fords of Galicia. Late afternoon, arrive in Santiago de Compostela - one of the Western World's most desirable spots of pilgrimage, and home to one of the world's largest churches, St. James of Compostela. The town is truly dominated by the famous Shrine. Check in at hotel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Santiago de Compostela. (B,D)

Day 5 September 18, Tuesday: Santiago de Compostela

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we start our tour of the Pilgrim's Way. Walk from Avenida de los Concheiros to Cruz de San Pedro and on to Puerta del Carmen, Rua Casa Reales to Azabacheria and on to the Cathedral, the Shrine of St. James. According to legend, the bones of the Apostle St. James the Great (Santiago), brother of the Evangelist John, were transported to Spain after his martyrdom in AD 44 and placed at the site of the Cathedral in the year 813. **Celebrate Mass at the Cathedral.** (Possibility to see the swinging "botafumeiro", a five-foot high thurible suspended by a two hundred foot rope.) An impressive feature of the Cathedral is the Portico de la Gloria, which is located just inside the main entrance. Through the centuries, millions of pilgrims have touched the central pillar. The relics of St. James repose in the high altar. Pilgrims can follow the centuries-old tradition of climbing the stairs behind the altar to kiss the shells that rest on the golden statue of the saint. Below the statue is the crypt that contains the bones of St. James in a silver reliquary. Independent lunch. Free time to explore and visit the Church and the Convent of San Francisco, commemorating the pilgrimage made here by St. Francis of Assisi between 1213 and 1215. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Santiago de Compostela. (B,D)

Day 6 September 19, Wednesday: El Camino de Santiago | Leon | Avila

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Today, we travel through the Pilgrims Segment of the Way of St. James into Galicia. This area is Spain's westernmost region and most obscure, with a culture, language and customs all its own. Along the Way of St. James, we **celebrate Mass at the Chapel of O'Cebreiro** known for the Eucharistic Miracle of the Host. Late morning, arrive in Leon, the capital of Christian Spain at the start of the Reconquest. Visit the old town and the Churches of Santa Ana, Santa Maria del Mercado, and the Convent of Conception. The highlight of this exploration is the remarkable Cathedral built in pure Gothic style. Daylight filters through no less than 12,917 square feet of stained-glass windows. Tradition requires that all pilgrims rest their hands on a small pedestal in the church, so as to receive special protection for their pilgrimage. Independent lunch in Leon. In the afternoon, we leave Leon and drive south to Avila, City of Kings and of Saints, completely encircled by 11th Century walls. The city walls are the symbolic emblems of the city. They contribute to the defining image of this warring and monastic center and constitute a unique symbol that encloses within its walls mysticism and history, art and heroic chivalry. This is the birthplace of St. Teresa, one of the greatest mystics and Doctor of the Church. Check in at our hotel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Avila. (B,D)

Day 7 September 20, Thursday: Avila | Zaragoza

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we tour the city of Avila. Visit the place where St. Teresa was born and baptized. Visit St. Vincent's Church in honor of its martyr, it is one of the monumental complexes of Avila. Continue to visit the Cathedral, which contains many relics of St. Teresa. Continue on to visit the crypt of the Convento of La

Santa, built on the site of the house where she was born and home to a comprehensive museum, is dedicated to her life. Continue on to visit the convent of La Encarnación where St. Teresa became a Carmelite. **Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of Transverberation**, meaning "Stigmata of the Heart". After Mass, visit the convent of San Jose, a monastery of Discalced Carmelite Nuns, and the first monastery founded by St. Teresa. Independent lunch in Avila. In the afternoon, we leave Avila for Zaragoza. One of the greatest monumental towns in Spain, Zaragoza was founded over 2000 years ago. Still evident in the city are the remains of the Old Iberian, Roman, Gothic and Arabian empires which ruled long ago. Zaragoza presents an impressive landscape with picturesque villages and some of the most important buildings of the Spanish baroque style. Upon arrival we will visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, an important pilgrimage spot because Our Lady visited Zaragoza before her Assumption. Tradition holds that Our Lady, while still alive, appeared to St. James to encourage him in his evangelization. As a sign of her protection, Mary left him the pillar with her statue. The pillar, which still emits an extraordinary fragrance, can be venerated in the church. Four towers flank the building, constructed in 1681. Its cupola boasts murals painted by Goya, and the church museum houses a large collection of religious art. Check in at our hotel in Zaragoza. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Zaragoza. (B,D)

Day 8 September 21, Friday: Zaragoza | Loyola | Lourdes

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we leave Zaragoza for Azpeitia and Loyola, to visit the baroque monastery of Ignatius de Loyola, founder of the Jesuit order. Visit the Basilica of St. Ignatius and Loyola Castle, where St. Ignatius Loyola was born. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** After Mass, continue northeast across the border of Spain and France through the Pyrenees Mountains to Lourdes. Independent lunch en route. In the afternoon, we arrive in Lourdes. Few are prepared by what they have read or seen in pictures to grasp the sheer beauty of Lourdes. It is more dramatic and larger than you expect. The people you meet there are considered by some as "the most amazing part of the entire experience". At night, they stroll the narrow streets singing aloud, laughing and full of joy. They come from all nations. Smiling faces seem to break down language barriers. Whether pilgrims experience another miracle or not, they consider it miracle enough to find themselves, at last, in Lourdes. Check-in at our hotel. Dinner at the hotel restaurant. **In the evening, at 8:45pm, join in the candlelight procession and recitation of the Rosary while singing of hymns to honor the Mother of God.** Overnight at the hotel in Lourdes. (B,D)

Day 9 September 22, Saturday: Full Day in Lourdes

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. **Liturgies at the Grotto are scheduled on the hour, 6:00 am to 7:00 pm, with the English Mass time advised only two weeks prior to departure.** Celebrate Mass at the Grotto. After Mass we will walk in the footsteps of St. Bernadette and see the Holy Mill, where St. Bernadette was born; the Locale Mill, residence of her parents; the "Cochot," formerly used as a jail where she lived at the time of the Apparitions; the Chapel where St. Bernadette received her First Holy Communion; and the Parish church containing the Baptismal Font where she was baptized. Join your pray for the sick, drink water from the miraculous springs, or submerge yourself in the healing baths. Experience Christ's love as you walk the life-sized Stations of the Cross overlooking the holy Grotto. Kneel in the chapel built on the very rock of the Grotto, in obedience of the request of the Immaculate Conception. In a square to the side is the Chapel of Reconciliation, where the Redemptorist Fathers are available for confessions in many languages. Independent lunch. Dinner at the hotel restaurant. **In the evening, at 8:45pm, attend the evening Torchlight Marian procession.** In addition to all the pilgrims from around the world, each night the entire town of Lourdes seems to descend on the Sanctuary. The evening Procession begins from the Grotto and ends in the square in front of the Rosary Basilica. During the procession, the pilgrims walk in groups behind their pilgrimage banner. Everyone is invited to carry a lighted candle as a reminder of Baptism. Overnight at the hotel in Lourdes. (B,D)

Day 10 September 23, Sunday: Lourdes | Montserrat | Barcelona

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we leave Lourdes for Montserrat. Independent lunch upon arrival in Montserrat, followed by a guided visit of the beautiful Benedictine Abbey of Montserrat. For over a thousand years pilgrims from everywhere in Europe have made their way to the Benedictine Shrine of the Cherished Black Madonna, said to have been carved by St. Luke. Visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Montserrat and the Benedictine Monastery standing 2,379 feet above sea level, surrounded by jagged peaks and massive rock formations that present a fantastic primeval appearance. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** After Mass, we continue to Barcelona for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Barcelona. (B,D)

Day 11 September 24, Monday: Highlights of Barcelona | Farewell Dinner

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. We begin our day with an orientation tour of Barcelona, including the art deco works of native Antonio Gaudi (1852 - 1926), Sagrada Familia (Church of the Holy Family). Due to Gaudi's untimely death, the Church on which he had first started to work in 1884 was left incomplete in 1926. The design was begun in conventional Neo-Gothic. He completed the crypt, the famous Nativity facade with its four tall spires and the porch laden with naturalistic sculpture. The work was restarted in 1940, however, at a great disadvantage. Gaudi had left no plans and no one was able to imitate his free interpretation of Gothic motifs. The Church has become a symbolic monument for Barcelona, visited by more people than any other site. Continue on to visit to Montjuich Hill, the site of the 1992 Olympics, and enjoy a spectacular view of Barcelona and its port area. Continue to the Gothic Quarter to visit the magnificent Cathedral, the Church of Santa Maria del Mar, and the exterior of the Palau de la Generalitat, the Town Hall, the small streets that lead to the Plaza Real, Avenue Paseo de Garcia, and Las Ramblas. Independent lunch and afternoon at leisure. Early evening transfer to the **Cathedral of St. Eulalia and Sacred Heart for Mass.** After Mass, we will enjoy a farewell dinner at a restaurant in Barcelona. Overnight in Barcelona. (B,D)

Day 12 September 25, Tuesday: Return to the USA

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to Barcelona International Airport for our return flight to the USA. Arrive at Chicago O'Hare International Airport, overflowing with memories. (B)

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. A discount of \$100.00 per person will apply for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late reservation fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months**, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip on **Swiss Airlines/Lufthansa Airlines from Chicago O'Hare International Airport**. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. **All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently.** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (**\$2,945.00 per person sharing a twin room.**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available but we discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of **\$695.00**. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities to the tour manager/guide, and driver are not included in the package price. For good work, we recommend 4,00 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; 2,00 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; 1,50 Euro per person for a local guide. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate.
