A referral award is part of a defined referral award program. A referral award is paid to a current St. Dominic Catholic School family who successfully recruits and/or refers a new student to St. Dominic Catholic School and also offers awards for new families who enroll students.

Please see program documentation for eligibility, policies and program award information. The referring family must complete the referral family certificate prior to the referred family contacting St. Dominic Catholic School. Exceptions may be made for those referred families who clearly identify the family who referred them at their initial contact with the school.

Once a family is referred to St. Dominic Catholic School, a school representative will contact the family to invite them to tour our school, shadow in the classroom, and provide any additional information requested.

Superior Academics:

- Our students excel on the Iowa Test of Basic Skills. For the last eight years our students' average score was in the 97th percentile of national school norms.
- Consistently, 100 percent of St. Dominic eighth graders score at the proficient or advanced level in Math, Reading and Social Studies on the Wisconsin Knowledge and Concepts Examination (WKCE).
- Historically, our students have performed significantly better on the WKCE than Elmbrook School District students in all subject areas.
